Saturday and Sunday Morning Hikes

The Saturday morning hike is at the camp. There will be a one mile walkabout through the trees and over the creek.

Location: The Ribbon Trailhead (Old Gordon Trail) off of Little Park Road. Google map coordinates: (38.9947180, -108.6426210) (Google Maps)

INFO: There is a restroom/outhouse facility at the trailhead. Easy 5-10-minute walk to reach destination. Accessible for all ages. No entry fee since it is outside the Colorado National Monument. It is a 21-minute drive from the Sunday morning venue at the Avalon Theatre.
